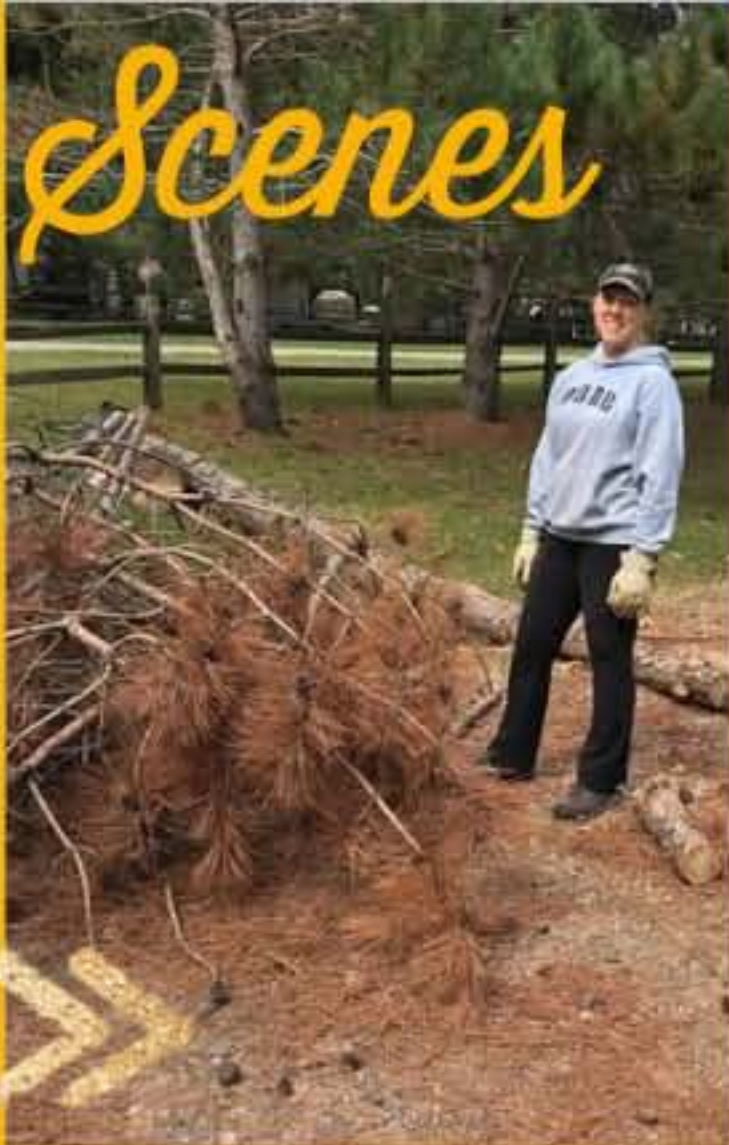


Behind the Scenes

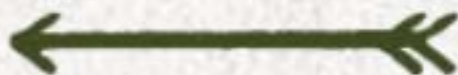

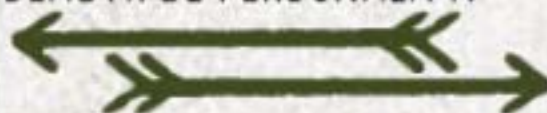
